

## Earthquake Kits

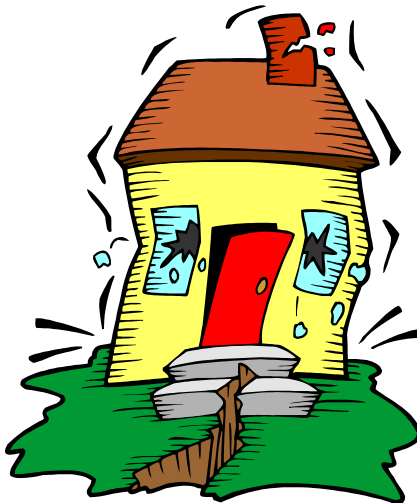
### Reminder!

First start with a large Ziploc bag—labeled with your child's name & classroom.

Then add:

- A large trash bag
- Small flashlight with new batteries
- Socks
- Mittens
- Small package Kleenex
- Note of encouragement (letter from you for child to calm child)
- Picture of your family
- A small toy
- Non-perishable snack (granola bar, energy bar, etc.)
- 2 juice packs

In addition to your individual bags, SonShine Preschool & Kindergarten has a large earthquake kit which has additional supplies like a porta-potty, space blankets, first aid kit, etc.



## Health Policies

Please notify the staff if your child:

- Contracts or is exposed to a communicable disease
- Has any specific medical condition or allergies
- Requires medication
- Has received a new immunization

When children are sick - On advice of health experts, we will not allow children with any of the following symptoms to be or remain in our care:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Vomiting (on 2 or more occasions with 24 hours)
- Diarrhea (3 or more watery stools within 24 hours)
- Draining rash or sore
- Eye discharge or pinkeye
- Lice or scabies (children may be readmitted after treatment and if there are no nits)

When children need medicine - The SonShine Preschool will not dispense any medications. Children may not bring any medicine to school. All medicines must be given prior to coming to school/or after going home.



### Facts About Spreading of Germs & Hand Washing

Help your family stay healthy!

Encourage your children to wash their hands! Have them wash their hands when arriving at preschool, and also when they get home from preschool.

Another tip: At home you should change your hand-towels, as well as any kitchen towels or dishrags daily.

Remember Grandma having the kitchen towels that had the days of the week embroidered on them? Besides being cute, this helped make sure she had a clean one every day!
