Today your child brought home their weekly folder. (Thank you for remembering to return them on Wednesday) In it you will find many things your child worked hard on this week. This week we learned the letter Uu. Please review the short Uu sound at home this week. Other things in your child's folder were a big, medium and small apple project, an umbrella with short U and long U raindrops, a five senses Under the Umbrella book, letter U writing papers, an October calendar and a newsletter from Sandbox Learning. Please take time to go through these things with your child and let your child tell you about them.

Kindergarten Parent's, In addition to these things your child brought home a book called A Cub. Please have your child read this story to you. Help your child point to each word as he/she reads. While several children are "really" reading, others will have memorized the book. Both are stages in early reading. Help your child succeed by reading with him/her every night! We are also learning the parts of a book. Please have your child show you the cover, title page and dedication page. Other vocabulary words include author and illustrator.

Our number of the week was number 2. We learned different ways to make 2. Ask your child to show you two different ways to make two! Math vocabulary includes, plus and equals.
